After completing pilot trials, <u>How2Recycle (H2R)</u> is launching updated labels and a new education and outreach campaign aimed at further reducing consumer confusion and improving U.S. recycling rates. The H2R label is a standardized on-package labeling system that clearly communicates recycling instructions to the public. Post is committed to implementing H2R labels across our portfolio of brands and products.

Leaves Are Turning Red, But Keep Your Mind On Staying Green

Temperatures are getting cooler, days shorter and the holidays are just around the corner. While I enjoy this time of year, I always remind myself around now that this also means lights must stay on longer, heat will kick on and winter is on the way! With this in mind, here are my top 5 tips for the fall transition:
